FLINTSHIRE JOINT PLANNING COMMITTEE.

NOTICE is hereby given that (1) on the tenth day of June, 1937, the Minister of Health notified his approval with modifications of the resolution of the Flintshire Joint Planning Committee dated the tenth day of December, 1936, deciding to prepare the above planning Scheme with reference to an area comprising the Borough of Flint, the Urban Districts of Prestatyn, Holywell, Mold, Connah's Quay and Buckley, and the Rural Districts of Hawarden, Holywell and St. Asaph; (2) a certified copy of the Map defining the area to which the resolution applies has been deposited at the following places, namely,

County Buildings, Mold; Town Hall, Flint; U.D.C. Offices, Buckley; U.D.C. Offices, Connah's Quay; Town Hall, Holywell; Council Offices, Prestatyn; R.D.C. Offices, Hawarden and R.D.C. Offices, St. Asaph,

and will be open for inspection by all persons interested without charge between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. every week-day with the exception of Saturday when the hours will be 10 a.m. till 12 o'clock noon; (3) any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property in the area to which the resolution (as modified) applies and any association representing owners of property within the several

districts above specified and any local association representing business or industry may by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Flintshire Joint Planning Committee to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,* the development of land in the area (to which the resolution as modified applies) during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the following Authorities namely, the Councils of the Borough of Flint, the Urban Districts of Prestatyn, Holywell, Mold, Connah's Quay and Buckley, and the Rural Districts of Hawarden, Holywell and St. Asaph are empowered to permit other development in their respective districts during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the Scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map.

The Flintshire Joint Planning Committee intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a draft Scheme and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the draft Scheme should be sent in writing to the Clerk to the Committee.
