NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Department of Health for Scotland, acting jointly so far as regards regulations which the said Joint Committee are empowered to make jointly with the said Minister and the said Department, and the said Minister and the said Department acting separately so far as regards regulations which they are empowered to make alone, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the several powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Exempt Persons) Amendment Regulations, 1937.
