BRIDPORT GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade forthwith by the Bridport Gas Company, Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") whose address is the Gas Works, Bridport, for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following (amongst other) purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorise the Company to supply gas within the following areas in the County of Dorset (in this Notice referred to as "the limits of supply") viz.:—

The borough of Bridport and the parishes of Askerswell Burton Bradstock Bothenhampton Bradpole Chilcombe Chideock Litton Cheney Loders Punccknowle Shipton Gorge Swyre Symondsbury Whitchurch Canonicorum (except such portion of that parish as lies west of a line drawn along the east bank of the River Char from the point at which the boundary between the last mentioned parish and the parish of Marshwood intersects that bank to the south-east corner of Whitchurch Bridge and thence true south) and so much of the parish of Stanton St. Gabriel as lies east of the said line drawn true south from the said south-east corner of Whitchurch Bridge all which parishes and parts of parishes are in the rural district of Bridport and the parishes of Netherbury and Powerstock in the rural district of Beaminster.

2. To prescribe the date or dates upon which the several provisions of the intended Order shall come into operation.

3. To authorise the Company to continue maintain and use any existing gas mains pipes and works belonging to them within the limits of supply and to apply to such mains pipes

and works the provisions of the intended Order and of the Acts incorporated therewith.

4. To define and limit the capital and borrowing powers of the Company for the purposes of the undertaking to be authorised by the intended Order, which undertaking is in this Notice referred to as "the undertaking."

5. To make provisions as to the sale by auction or tender of shares issued by the Company for the purposes of the undertaking.

6. To empower the directors of the Company to reserve a proportion of any future issue of shares for the purposes of the undertaking for exclusive offer to employees of the Company and to consumers of gas supplied by the Company and to make provisions as to the terms and conditions of issue.

7. To empower the Company with the consent of the Board of Trade to offer shares for subscription by employees of the Company and to consumers of gas supplied by the Company without first offering the same for sale by public auction or tender.

8. To empower the Company to maintain, erect, alter, improve and renew gasworks with all necessary machinery and apparatus and to make and store gas and to work up and convert residual products upon the lands hereinafter described and to purchase and use material required to work up and convert residual products.

The said lands are:

(a) A piece of land in the Borough of Bridport belonging or reputed to belong to the Company containing 1.446 acres or thereabouts bounded on the north by land belonging or reputed to belong to the Mayor Aldermen and burgesses of the said Borough on the south by land belonging or reputed to belong to Henry Robert Cleaves Palmer on the east by South Street and on the west by the River Brit.

(b) A piece of land in the parish of Symondsbury in the Rural District of Bridport belonging or reputed to belong to the Company containing 1.927 acres or thereabouts and forming the enclosure numbered 691 in the said parish on the ²⁵⁰⁰/₂₅₀₀ Ordnance Map Dorset Sheet XXXVIII.10. (Edition of 1930).

9. To empower the Company to purchase lands by agreement and to hold the same and to sell or lease any lands vested in or acquired by them.

10. To authorise the Company to purchase or take on lease, houses for employees and offices, showrooms and buildings for the purposes of the undertaking, to erect, maintain and let buildings, and to provide, maintain and equip recreation grounds for the use and benefit of their employees.

11. To make provision as to the declaration by the Company from time to time of the calorific value or values of the gas to be supplied by them and the alteration of such calorific value or values, and to make provision as to the pressure of the gas to be supplied by the Company.

12. To provide that the Company shall charge for gas supplied by them according to the number of heat units contained therein and to make provisions as to the method of ascertainment of the number of heat units supplied.
