

the Rural District of East Dean with the exception of the Parishes of Churcham and Huntley and any local association representing business or industry may by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Forest of Dean Joint Planning Committee to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Lydney, West Dean and East Dean Rural District Councils are empowered to permit other development in their respective districts during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map.

The Forest of Dean Joint Planning Committee intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme should be sent in writing to the Hon. Secretary to the Committee.
