BOROUGH OF KING'S LYNN.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

ROAD AND RAIL TRAFFIC ACT, 1933.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 14th June, 1937, the Minister of Transport modified and confirmed the Borough of King's Lynn Roads (Restriction) Order (No. 2), 1936, made by the Council of the Borough of King's Lynn under Section 46 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930 and Section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933.

The Order as modified provides that, with certain exceptions, no person shall drive, or cause to be driven any heavy locomotive, light locomotive, motor tractor or heavy motor car or any motor car with seats for more than seven persons exclusive of the driver on Chapel Lane or Pilot Street between its junction with Chapel Lane and its junction with North Street, King's Lynn.

The Order is available for inspection at the Town Hall, King's Lynn.
