

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter III, section 5, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent of the Benefice of Gedling, in the County of Nottingham and in the Diocese of Southwell, and to his successors Incumbents of the same Benefice, the yearly sum being the interest or dividends arising in respect of a sum of £5,833 6s. 8d. £3 per centum Funding Stock (1959-69), or in respect of other the investments for the time being representing the same, such yearly sum to be payable out of the Common Fund under our control and to be calculated as from the 11th day of June, 1937: Provided always that such yearly sum or any portion thereof shall be payable only upon the production to us, from time to time, of a certificate (in such form as may be required by us) under the hand of the Bishop of the Diocese certifying that, during the period then ended, there has been employed within the Parish of the Benefice and duly licensed by such Bishop an Assistant Curate in receipt of a stipend of an annual amount not less than the dividends arising in respect of the said investment: Provided also that the yearly sum so granted shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the Parish and Benefice.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Rochdale Vicarage Act, 1866 (29th and 30th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter 86), and also in pursuance of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her said late Majesty, chapter III, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant out of the "Rochdale Vicarage Fund" created under the tenth section of the said Rochdale Vicarage Act, 1866, to the Incumbent for the time being of each of the three Benefices the names whereof are stated in the first column of the Schedule hereto, and to his successors Incumbents of the same Benefice, one yearly sum or stipend of the amount stated in the second column of the Schedule opposite to the name of the Benefice, each such yearly sum or stipend to be calculated as from the first day of May, 1937, and to be payable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August and the first day of November in each and every year. Provided always that each of the said yearly sums or stipends hereby granted shall terminate upon the cessation of the pension charged on the revenues of the Benefice concerned in favour of the clergyman named in the third column of the Schedule opposite to the name of the Benefice.
