The following Statute made by the University of Oxford on the 24th day of June, 1937, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

## UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD.

STATUTE APPROVED BY CONGREGATION ON THURSDAY, 24 JUNE, 1937.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Statute concerning Elections to Professorships: Now the University, in exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and of all other powers enabling it, enacts, subject to the approval of His Majesty in Council, as follows:—

- 1. In Statt. Tit. IV. Sect. 1. § 2 (a) (Statuta, 1936, p. 49) delete clause 1 (ll. 24-6) and substitute the following new clause:
  - "I. When a Professorship within the University becomes vacant or is about to become vacant the Registrar shall give notice to the Hebdomadal Council as soon as convenient provided that notification shall not be given later than the first meeting of Council after a vacancy has occurred."
- 2. Ibid. (l. 27), delete clause 2 and substitute the following clause:
  - "2. The Hebdomadal Council shall then resolve either that the necessary steps be taken for an election to the vacant office to be made or that they be suspended for a time to be fixed by the resolution; and this suspension may be renewed from time to time, provided always that the whole period of suspension shall not exceed one year from the date on which the vacancy occurred,
