SUSPENSION OF WITHDRAWAL OF AUTHORISATIONS.

REGINALD GEORGE KARN.

The Home Secretary gives notice that he has suspended until further Order the operation of the Notice, dated 11th October, 1929, and published in the London Gazette and Edinburgh Gazette on the 11th October, 1929, withdrawing from Reginald George Karn, M.R.C.S., L.R.C.P., now of 9, Spanish Place Mansions, London, W.1, the authority granted by the Regulations made under the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1920, to duly qualified medical practitioners to be in possession of and to supply raw opium, coca leaves and Indian hemp, and the drugs and preparations to which Part III of the Act applies; and has also suspended the direction given at the same time, that it should not be lawful for Mr. Karn to give prescriptions for the purposes of the aforesaid Regulations.
