The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that an Open Competitive Examination for situations as Clerical Assistant, Grade I (Female), in the Civil Service and Clerical Assistant (Female) in Offices of Inspectors of Taxes under the Inland Revenue Department will be held on the 1st April, 1938, under the Regulations dated the 29th December, 1936, and published in the London Gazette of the same date.

The towns at which a vacancy or vacancies will be filled on the result of this competition are as follows, viz.:—

The Examinations are restricted to persons whose homes are in or near the town for which they desire to compete.

No person will be admitted to Examination from whom the Secretary of the Civil Service Commission has not received on or before the 27th January, 1938, an application in the candidate's own handwriting, on the prescribed form, which may be obtained from the Secretary at once.

The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that the following Regulations are published with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, viz.:—

REGULATIONS RESPECTING OPEN COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS FOR THE EXECUTIVE GROUP OF SITUATIONS, THAT IS TO SAY, FOR THE GENERAL EXECUTIVE CLASS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE, FOR EXECUTIVE BRANCHES OF THE DEFENCE DEPARTMENTS, AND FOR THE SITUATIONS OF ASSISTANT AUDITOR IN THE EXCHEQUER AND AUDIT DEPARTMENT, ASSISTANT EXAMINER IN THE ESTATE DUTY OFFICE OF THE INLAND REVENUE DEPARTMENT, ACTUARIAL ASSISTANT IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT ACTUARY, AUDIT ASSISTANT IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH, AND ASSISTANT INSPECTOR ON THE OUTDOOR STAFF OF THE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT OF THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH, THE WELSH BOARD OF HEALTH AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR SCOTLAND.

With the exception of posts in executive branches in the Defence Departments, for which men only are eligible, competitions under these regulations are open both to men and women.

These regulations are liable to alteration from time to time.

1. Candidates must have attained the age of 18 and must not have attained the age of 19 on the first day of March in the year in which the competition is held.

In reckoning age for competition the following allowances will be made, viz.:—

(a) Candidates who have served or are serving in the Navy, Army or Air Force may deduct from their actual age any time during which they have so served.

(b) Candidates who have served in any established civil situation to which they were admitted with the Certificate of the Civil Service Commissioners may deduct from their actual age any time not exceeding two years which they may have spent in such service.
