

(c) The Office of the Clerk to the Wellingborough Urban District Council, Wellingborough;

and will be open for inspection by all persons interested without charge at the office of (a) above between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays (except Thursdays) and between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Thursdays; and at the offices of (b) and (c) above between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays (except Saturdays) and between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays; (3) any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property in the area and any association representing owners of property within the above-named Borough and Urban and Rural Districts and any local association representing business or industry may by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Mid-Northamptonshire Planning Committee to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933.\*

the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Council of the above-named Borough as regards the Borough, and the above-named District Councils as regards their respective districts are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map and copies thereof.

The Mid-Northamptonshire Planning Committee intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme or Schemes and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme or Schemes should be sent in writing to the Honorary Secretary to the Mid-Northamptonshire Planning Committee.
