FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED
AREAS) ORDER OF 1937 (No. 91).

SUBJECT.

Substitutes the area described in the Schedule for the area No. 2 described in the Schedule to Order No. 5602 and revokes Article 2 of that Order.

SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising:—

In the county of East Sussex.

The county borough of Brighton.

The borough of Hove.

The petty sessional divisions of Haywards Heath (*except so much of the parish of Slaugham as lies to the north of the road running from Horsham via Slaugham Common and Slaugham Church to Staplefield and except the said road*) and Hove including its detached part.

The parishes of Chailey, Ditchling, Westmeston, Streat, Plumpton, East Chiltington, Stanmer and Falmer, so much of the parish of West Hoathly as lies to the south-west of the road running from Turner's Hill via Selsfield Lodge, West Hoathly and Sharpthorne to Tyes Cross and so much of the parishes of Danehill, Fletching and Newick as lies to the south and west of the road running from Horsted Keynes via Danehill, Danehurst Heaven Farm, Sheffield Green, Sheffield Bridge and Lane End Common to Chailey.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

Caernarvonshire Rivers Catchment Area.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives notice that the Caernarvonshire Rivers Catchment Board have made application under sub-section (3) of Section 5 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, that the statutory map of the Catchment Area be varied so far as relates to the extent of the "main river", by adding to the "main river" as shown on the said map the River Glaslyn from its present termination as "main river" to Llyn Gwynant, and the River Colwyn from its junction with the River Glaslyn to Pont Alun.

A copy of the statutory map on which the proposed variation is to be made may be inspected at the offices of the Catchment Board, County Offices, Caernarvon, or at the offices of the Ministry. Any objection to the proposed variation of the statutory map shall be made in writing and sent by post addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, at the address mentioned below, so as to reach that office within thirty-one days from the date of this notice.
