PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES.

In accordance with Regulations made by the Minister of Labour under section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, and dated 21st April, 1927, the Milk Distributive Trade Board (England and Wales) hereby give notice that they propose to vary, in respect of certain classes of male workers, the minimum rates of wages at present set out in their Notices M.D. (16) and M.D. (19) dated 23rd November, 1931, and 14th January, 1938, respectively. Particulars of the proposed variations may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Trade Board at the address given below.

In accordance with section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, the Trade Board will consider any objections to the proposed variations which may be lodged with them within two months from 14th January, 1938. Any such objection should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her address), and should be sent to the Secretary, Milk Distributive Trade Board (England

and Wales), Metropole Buildings, Northumberland Avenue, London, W.C.2. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise grounds of their objections.
