

by road and footpath past Small Shaw Height to the road junction on the main road from Weir to Bacup at Broad Clough.

Eastern Boundary.

Thence in a southerly direction through Bacup by way of Bridge Street, St. James Street, South Street, and Tong Lane and in a south-easterly direction past Britannia to Trough Gate. Thence in a southerly direction along the London Midland and Scottish Railway to the point where it crosses the River Spodden about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Broadley Railway Station. Thence following the right bank of the river in a south-westerly direction for about 1,200 feet. Thence in a west-north-westerly direction along the footpath and in a south-westerly direction along the road to Catley Lane Head. Thence along the road in a southerly direction to the cross-roads about 1,600 feet east of Shawfield.

Southern Boundary.

Thence following the road running in a general south-westerly direction, crossing the main Rochdale-Haslingden road and Cheesden Brook to its junction with the main road from Rochdale to Bury about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east of Woodgate Hill. Thence in a west-south-westerly direction along the main road past Jericho to the road junction about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south-west of Woodgate Hill. Thence in a general north-westerly direction along the road past the golf course to Walmersley, thence westwards along the road over the River Irwell, passing south of Green Mount to Hawkshaw Lane End. Thence in a westerly direction for about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the cross-roads by the Inn.

Western Boundary.

Thence in a north-north-westerly direction along the road past Edgworth and Wayoh Fold to the cross-roads by the Inn north of Whittlestone Head. Thence in a northerly direction by the road and footpath passing Hoddlesden Moss and Hoddlesden to Waterside. Thence along the road in an easterly and north-easterly direction to the road junction at Cocker Brook, the point of departure.

An Area of approximately 170 square miles situated in the County of York.

Northern Boundary.

Commencing at Borrage Bridge in Ripon and passing westward through the town by way of Low Skellgate, Somerset Row, Firby Lane, Blossomgate and Kirkby Road. Thence in a north-westerly direction along the road past Gooseberry and Red House to the road junction by Burntroots Plantation. Thence in a general west-south-westerly direction along the road past Azerley Park through Kirkby Malzeard by the southerly road, past Swetton and over Fountains Earth Moor to the point where the road crosses the railway west of Bouthwaite.

Western Boundary.

Thence along the railway in a south-easterly direction to the point where it crosses the road from Ramsgill to Wath. Thence following the said road in an easterly direction to Wath and in a south-easterly direction past Silver Hill to Pateley Bridge. Thence following the main

road in a general south-easterly direction past Wilsill to the cross-roads at Summer Bridge. Thence in a south-westerly and southerly direction along the road past Dacre Banks, Dacre, Hardgroves Hill and Dangerous Corner to the road junction at Worstall Crags. Thence in a general south-westerly direction along the road which passes between the Fewston and Swinsty Reservoirs and past Beecroft Moor Plantation to the cross-roads east of Sourby Farm. Thence following the road in a general southerly direction past Shaw Hall and Whin Castle to the road junction as Askwith.

Southern Boundary.

Thence in a south-easterly direction along the road past Weston and Throstle Nest to the road junction at Newall about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east of Ashfield House. Thence for a short distance in a north-easterly direction along the Farnley road to the road junction at the southern end of Otley Plantation. Thence in an easterly direction along the road which skirts the south side of Farnley Park to its junction with the road from Leathley to Pool. Thence in a southerly and south-easterly direction along the said road to the cross-roads at Street Close. Thence following the road in an east-north-easterly direction to Wescoehill and in an easterly direction past Weeton to Dunkseswick. Thence in a northerly direction to Moor End and in a general north-easterly direction past Swindon Lodge to Kirkby Overblow. Thence along the footpath running in an easterly and north-easterly direction through Spofforth Park to the road junction by Spofforth Railway Station.

Eastern Boundary.

Thence following the main road in a general northerly direction past Hell Hole to the road junction near Plompton Square. Thence along the road running in a north-easterly and northerly direction past Plompton High Grange and Low Grange to Grimbald Bridge, thence continuing northwards along the road which passes east of Knaresborough to the fork roads about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south-east of Farnham, thence along the right fork road past Occaney to the cross-roads about 700 feet south-west of the Church at Copgrove. Thence in a west-north-westerly direction along the road past Burton Leonard to its junction with the main road from Ripley to Ripon. Thence following the said main road in a northerly direction to Borrage Bridge in Ripon, the point of departure.

An Area of approximately 130 square miles situated in the Counties of York and Lancaster.

Northern Boundary.

Commencing at the point where the main road from Grassington to Pateley Bridge crosses the River Dibb at Dibble's Bridge situated in the County of York about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of Hebden and about 8 miles north-north-east of Skipton. Thence following the left bank of the River Dibb in a north-easterly direction to the Reservoir. Thence in an easterly and east-north-easterly direction by way of a footpath and road to the road junction at the eastern end of the Reservoir, thence along the road running for a short distance in
