ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930—SECTION 46 (3).

COUNTY OF EAST SUFFOLK.

Notice is hereby given that on the 24th January, 1938, the Minister of Transport made an Order under Section 46 (3) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, further amending the provisions of an Order dated 14th December, 1927, made under Section 7 (4) of the Roads Act, 1920, which prohibited the driving of certain classes of mechanically-propelled vehicles on various highways in the County of East Suffolk.

The effect of the amending Order is to delete the reference, in the first Schedule to the Order, to the Rural District of Woodbridge and the road from its junction with the Felixstowe-Woodbridge Main Road (A. 1093) near Bucklesham Chapel via Catts Corner near Kembroke Hall, and Kirton Brook to the road junction at Kirton Green.

RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiry of at least forty day from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make the London Traffic (Parking Places) (Amendment) No. 2 Regulations, 1938:—

1. To appoint parking places in Wells Terrace and Highbury Station Road, Islington; Temple Fortune Lane and Beverley Gardens, Hendon; and Beechcroft Avenue, Cambridge Road, Church Avenue, Hamilton Road and Saxon Road, Southall.

2. To abolish the parking place in Upper Tooting Park, Balham.

3. To amend the limits of the parking place in Louisville Road, Balham.

4. To extend the parking place in Philpot Street, Stepney.

5. To make the necessary amendment to the existing Regulations by reason of the fact that Cross Street, Chelsea, has been renamed Stackhouse Street.
