FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1938 (No. 31).

SUBJECT.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Kelvedon, Essex, as from the 6th February, 1938, so as to comprise only the area described in the Schedule.

II. Releases the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Kelvedon, Essex, from restrictions and revokes Order No. 5634, as from the 13th February, 1938.

SCHEDULE.

Contracted Infected Area.

An Area comprising:—

In the county of Essex.

The parishes of Kelvedon, Little Coggeshall, Great Coggeshall, Markshall, Feering, Messingcum-Inworth including its detached part, Tip-tree, Tolleshunt Knights, Great Braxted, Little Braxted, Wickham Bishops, Witham, Bradwell, Pattiswick, Cressing, White Notley, Faulkbourne, Great Tey, Little Tey, Easthorpe,

Messing and Layer Marney; so much of the parish of Earls Colne as lies to the south of the road running from Halstead via Colne Green Farm and Earls Colne to Wakes Colne; so much of the parishes of Aldham, Marks Tey, Copford and Birch as lies to the south and west of the road running from Great Tey via Aldham Church, Marks Tey Station, Roman Road, Copford, Bockingham Hall, Hardy's Green, Birch Rectory, and Smyth's Green to Pods Wood; so much of the parishes of Tolleshunt D'Arcy, Tolleshunt Major, Little Totham and Great Totham as lies to the north and west of the road running from Salcott via Salcottstone Farm, Tolleshunt D'Arcy Station, Tolleshunt D'Arcy Church, Hill Farm, Tolleshunt Major, Little Renters Farm, White Horse Farm, Jepcracks Farm and Saints Farm to Broad Street Green; so much of the parish of Fairstead as lies to the east of the road running from Terling via Fairstead to Weststock Farm; and so much of the parish of Stisted as lies to the south-east of the road running from Halstead via Brooks's Farm, Stisted Rectory and Lyon's Hall to Bocking Church Street.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1938 (No. 32).

SUBJECT.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Shedfield, Hampshire, as from the 7th February, 1938, so as to comprise only the area described in the Schedule.

II. Releases the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Shedfield, Hampshire, from restrictions, and revokes Order No. 5635, as from the 14th February, 1938.

SCHEDULE.

Contracted Infected Area.

An Area comprising:—

In the county of Southampton.

The parishes of Upham, Durley, Curdrige, Curbridge, Botley, Bishop's Waltham, Droxford, Swanmore, Shedfield, Wickham, Corhampton and Meonstoke, and Soberton; so much of the parish of Hedge End as lies to the east of the road running from Horton Heath via Shamblehurst Farm, Lake Farm and Three Hills to Bursledon; and so much of the parishes of Fareham, Boarhunt, Southwick and Widley, Denmead, and Hambledon as lies to the north-east, north, north-west and west of the following boundary, namely:—the Fareham Branch of the Southern Railway line running from Bursledon to its junction with the Portsmouth Branch line of the Southern Railway, thence following that line in an easterly direction to its junction with the road running from Down-end House to Southwick and thence along that road via Port Nelson, Offwell Farm, Southwick Church, Creech Farm, Denmead Church, Pithill Farm, Pithill and Hambledon Church to Grenville Copse.
