- (b) A portion of Whinney Brook from Maghull Hall Brook to the Liverpool-Preston Road—a distance of approximately 600 yards.
- (c) The Old River Alt, from its present termination as main river at Dunnings Bridge to the Railway—a distance of approximately 600 yards.
- (d) Moor Hay Brook, from the River Alt to the new Dunnings Bridge Road-a distance of approximately 800 yards.

## SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACTS, 1923-1935.

NENE AND WELLAND DISTRICT FISHERY (EELS AND ELVERS) ORDER, 1937.
