The following Statute made by the Governing Body of Oriel College, in the University of Oxford, on the 19th day of January, 1938, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

ORIEL COLLEGE, OXFORD.

A STATUTE in relation to Oriel College in the University of Oxford duly made at a Special General Meeting of the Provost and Fellows of the said College specially summoned for the purpose and held on the nineteenth day of January, 1938.

Whereas by Statute IV, 6, as made by the University of Oxford Commissioners under the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and approved by the King in Council on the 30th day of April, 1926, in relation to Oriel College in the University of Oxford it was enacted as follows:—

" 6. The duties of Bible Clerks shall be entrusted to two of the Scholars or Exhibitioners who are in receipt of additional emoluments under clause 3 above, and these Scholars or Exhibitioners shall be entitled, in consideration of the performance of these duties, to exemption from the payment of fees to the Tuition Fund."

We, the said Provost and Fellows of the said College do hereby in exercise of the powers in

that behalf conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and of all other powers enabling it by this Statute passed at a Special General Meeting of the said College specially summoned for the purpose by the votes of not less than two-thirds of the number of persons present and voting alter Statute IV, 6, by adding after the words "entrusted to" the words "either one or."
