#### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1938 (No. 43).

##### SUBJECT.

I. Contracts as from 25th February, 1938,  
the Somerset and Dorset, Wilts, etc. Foot-and-  
Mouth Disease Infected Areas so as to form  
five separate areas as described in the First  
Schedule.

II. Revokes the Orders described in the  
Second Schedule.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE.

##### Area No. 1.

##### *Somerset Infected Area.*

An area in the county of Somerset  
comprising:—

The boroughs of Bridgwater, Glastonbury,  
Wells and Weston-super-Mare.

The petty sessional divisions of Weston-  
super-Mare (*except its detached part*),  
Axbridge, Wells, Somerton, Bridgwater  
(*except the parishes of Nether Stowey and Over  
Stowey; so much of the parishes of Spaxton  
and Enmore as lies to the south-west of the  
road running from Nether Stowey via Radlet  
Farm, Spaxton Lodge, Tutton's Farm and  
Barford House to Heathcombe House and  
except the said road; and so much of the parish  
of Broomfield as lies to the south-west of the  
road running from Tudball's Farm via Travel-  
ler's Rest, Ducks' Pool, Fyne Court and  
Oggshole Farm to West Monkton and except  
the said road*). Shepton Mallett (*except the  
parishes of Upton Noble, and Downhead*) and  
Temple Cloud (*except the parishes of Farm-  
borough, Timsbury and Paulton; and so much  
of the parish of High Littleton as lies to the  
east of the railway line running from Radstock  
to Clutton and except the said railway line*).

*In the petty sessional division of  
Long Ashton.*

The parishes of Kingston Seymour, Kenn,  
Yatton, Nailsea, Brockley, Backwell, Flax  
Bourton, Barrow Gurney, Dundry and  
Winford.

*In the petty sessional division of  
Kilmersdon.*

The parishes of Chilcompton, Stratton on the  
Fosse and Holcombe.

*In the petty sessional division of  
Wincanton.*

The parishes of Ansford, Castle Cary,  
Alford, Lovington, North Barrow, South  
Barrow and Sparkford.

to the east and south of the road running from  
Oggshole Farm via Hill Farm, Sidbrook, Bath-  
pool Church, Down's House and Halcon House  
to Taunton.

##### Area No. 2.

*Area around Yatton Keynell,  
Wilts.*

An Area comprising:—

#### IN THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE.

The borough of Chippenham.

The petty sessional division of Chippenham  
(*except the parishes of Sutton Benger and  
Christian Malford*).

*In the petty sessional division of  
Malmesbury.*

So much of the parishes of Luckington,  
Hullavington and St. Paul Malmesbury With-  
out as lies to the south of the Great Western  
Railway line running from Badminton Station  
to Little Somerford.

#### IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER.

*In the petty sessional division of  
Sodbury.*

The parish of Acton Turville; and so much  
of the parish of Marshfield as lies to the north-  
east of the road running from Dyrham Park  
via Springs Farm, Castle Farm, Marshfield,  
Ashwicke Grange, The Rocks and Three Shire  
Stones to Batheaston.

##### Area No. 3.
