Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make an Order confirming a scheme submitted to him by the Kent Rivers Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the amendment of the method of constituting the drainage board of the River Stour (Kent) Internal Drainage District, and for certain matters supplemental thereto.
