Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Acts, 1936.

WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act, 1936, and the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Mercantile Marine) (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, 1938;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Mercantile Marine) (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, 1938, to come into operation immediately as provisional rules, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.
