

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT,
1936.

WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACTS, 1936 AND 1937.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Acts, 1936 and 1937, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, 1938;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, 1938, to come into force immediately as provisional regulations, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT,
1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly or severally, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the several powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and subject to the approval of the Treasury and of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland so far as regards regulations with respect to which such approval is required, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Regulations, 1938;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly or severally, under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Regulations, 1938, to come into operation forthwith as provisional rules, to continue in force until

regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.

RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT,
1924.

ROAD AND RAIL TRAFFIC ACT, 1933.
