SCHEDULE.

The North Staffordshire District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930, shall be amended as follows:-

1. Clause 60 shall have effect as if in subclause (2) thereof-

- (a) there were substituted for the word "each" where that word occurs the second time the word "any";

 (b) for the words "failed to supply coal
- in pursuance of Consents issued to him or has persistently requested the Sales Committee not to issue Consents to him " there were substituted the words " neglected to supply his trade share of coal as hereinafter defined "; and
- (c) there were added at the end of the said sub-clause the words " and if any such revisions are made, the Sales Percentages of the other owners shall be adjusted consequentially in such manner as is fair and equitable to all the owners ".
- 2. Clause 65 shall have effect as if in paragraph (c) of sub-clause (3) thereof the words to a request to the Sales Committee by the owner not to issue any Consent to him, or "were omitted; and after the words "coal mine" there were inserted the words "or to the neglect of the owner to take all such measures as should reasonably have been taken in order to obtain his trade share for such quarter."
