NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules
Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by
the National Health Insurance Joint Com-
mittee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry
of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly
or severally, in pursuance of the several powers
conferred on them by the National Health
Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers
enabling them in that behalf, and subject to
the approval of the Treasury and of the
Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland so
far as regards regulations with respect to which
such approval is required, after the expiration
of at least forty days from this date, to make
regulations to be entitled the National Health
Insurance (Juvenile Contributors) (Interpreta-
tion) Regulations, 1938;

And that on account of urgency the National
Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister
of Health and the Ministry of Labour for
Northern Ireland, acting jointly or severally as
aforesaid, under section 2 of the Rules Publica-
tion Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the
National Health Insurance (Juvenile Contri-
butors) (Interpretation) Regulations, 1938, to
come into operation immediately as provisional
regulations, to continue in operation until
regulations have been made in accordance with
the provisions of section 1 of that Act.
