## MERCHANT SHIPPING ACTS, 1894 TO 1906.

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with the provisions of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that after the expiration of forty days from the date hereof, it is proposed to submit to His Majesty in Council the draft of an Order in Council under section 80 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1906, to provide for the registration as British Ships of vessels (not being Ships of War forming part of the Royal Navy) in the service of the Government of the Colony of Fiji.
