

Expenses of Committee.

10. No expenses shall be incurred by the Committee without the prior sanction of the Board, and the Secretary thereof shall keep accounts of any expenses properly incurred by or on behalf of the Committee in such form as the Board may from time to time direct.

Forms and Notices.

11. The forms and notices used by or on behalf of the Committee in respect of their functions shall be such as the Board may from time to time direct.

Returns and Information to the Board.

12. The Committee shall furnish to the Board such returns and information relating to the exercise and performance of the functions of the Committee, and to the complaints made to them with respect to the operation of the Scheme, as the Board may from time to time require.

Declaration of Secrecy.

13. Every member of the Committee and every officer of the Committee shall immediately on his appointment make and send to the Board a declaration of secrecy in such form as may be prescribed by the Board, and no person shall exercise or perform any functions as a member or officer of the Committee unless and until he shall have made such a declaration and sent the same to the Board.
