MANSFIELD GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Mansfield (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") whose address is the Town Hall, Mansfield, for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following, amongst other, purposes (that is to say):—

1. To extend the existing limits for the supply of gas by the Corporation by the addition to such limits of the parishes or townships of Ault Hucknall and Glapwell in the rural district of Blackwell in the Administrative County of Derby (which parishes or townships are hereinafter referred to as "the added limits"), and to authorise the Corporation to exercise within the added limits all the powers, rights, privileges and authorities for and in relation to the supply of gas which they have or may exercise from time to time within their existing limits.

2. To prescribe the price which may be charged by the Corporation for gas supplied by them within the added limits and to authorise the charging for gas within those limits of a price exceeding that authorised to be charged in the Borough of Mansfield.

3. To confer further powers upon the Corporation in regard to their gas undertaking and, amongst other things, to enact provisions empowering the Corporation for the purposes of the undertaking to purchase and use material for the conversion of residual products arising from the manufacture of gas by them or purchased by them; securing that all gas fittings let on hire by the Corporation, although fixed to premises or to the soil thereunder, shall continue to be the property of and removable by the Corporation; as to the recovery of sums due for gas fittings, etc. sold or let on hire by the Corporation and the application of the proceeds of the sale and hire of such fittings.

4. To make further provision with reference to the authentication and service of gas notices, the inclusion of several sums in one summons; and the recovery of demands and penalties.

5. To authorise the Corporation to borrow money for the payment of the costs and expenses of and connected with the Order.

6. To enable the Corporation to exercise all such powers as may be necessary or convenient for giving effect to the purposes of the Order, and to confer upon them all such other powers as are now usually conferred upon local authorities in connection with the supply of gas.

7. To vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with the objects of the Order and to confer other rights, powers and privileges.

8. To incorporate with Order with or without amendment or modification all or any of the provisions of the Gasworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1871, and the Acts amending those Acts respectively; and to alter, amend, repeal or reenact and extend to the Order (with or without modification) all or some of the provisions of the Mansfield Gas Acts and Orders, 1852 to 1934, and of any other Act or Order relating to the Corporation or their gas undertaking.
