LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Worplesdon, Surrey, as from the 12th September, 1938, so as to comprise only the area described in the Schedule.

The parish of Ash and Normandy and so much of the parish of Frimley as lies to the south of the Southern Railway line running from Farnborough Station to Brookwood Station.
