PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES.

In accordance with the Trade Boards (Notices) Regulations, 1927, the Rope, Twine and Net Trade Board (Great Britain) hereby give notice that they propose to vary minimum rates of wages for female homeworkers engaged in the hand braiding, hand knotting or hand baiting of nets, made from fibres other than hard fibres, at present set out in their Notice R. (56) dated 16th September, 1938.
