

Our will and pleasure is that Non-Administrative Colonels (Military) and Lieutenant-Colonels on the Special Selected List (Civil) of Our Indian Medical Service shall be permitted to remain in the Service until the age of 57; provided that a Non-Administrative Colonel (Military) or a Lieutenant-Colonel on the Special Selected List (Civil) who is offered an administrative appointment and declines to accept it shall be allowed to remain in the Service only until he reaches the age of 55, or if he has already attained that age, shall be thereupon retired from the Service.

Our Warrant dated 12th April, 1937, shall be amended accordingly.
