

Interference with Driver or Conductor.

17. No person other than the Conductor or Driver or other duly authorised officer of the Corporation shall change or remove the route indicators or destination boards or interfere with the controllers, brakes, switches, lights, ventilators, trolley cord, platform chains, or any part of a trolley vehicle or its equipment, and, except in a case of emergency or accident, no person other than the Conductor or other duly authorised officer of the Corporation shall signal a trolley vehicle to start or stop.

No passenger shall, when a trolley vehicle is in motion, speak to the Driver or distract his attention except in cases of emergency.

Disabled Trolley Vehicles.

18. If at any time a trolley vehicle becomes disabled, or in any way damaged, or from any cause unable to proceed, the passengers shall upon the request of the Conductor, leave the same, and if such passengers have paid their fares, they shall not be entitled to demand back the amount of their fares so paid, but on production of their tickets shall be entitled to travel by the next available trolley vehicle the remainder of the distance in respect of which they have paid their fares. No person shall, except with the permission of the Conductor, mount or enter a disabled or damaged trolley vehicle.

Obstructions.

19. No passenger shall wilfully obstruct or impede any officer or servant of the Corporation in the execution of his duty upon or in connection with any trolley vehicle or the trolley vehicle system of the Corporation.

Power to remove Passengers committing Offences.

20. Any person who shall commit whilst in or on any trolley vehicle, any breach of these byelaws shall, if the offence is continued, be liable in addition to incurring the penalty hereinafter provided, to be removed immediately from the trolley vehicle by or under the direction of the Conductor or other duly authorised officer of the Corporation, and if such person shall have paid his fare, he shall not be entitled to its return.

21. The Conductor and Driver of each trolley vehicle shall enforce or prevent the breach of these byelaws to the best of their ability.

22. Any person offending against or committing a breach of any of these byelaws shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding forty shillings.

23. There shall be placed and kept placed in a conspicuous position inside of each trolley vehicle in use a printed copy of these byelaws.

24. These byelaws shall come into force on the first day of January, 1939.
