November, 1938, the Minister of Transport con-
firmed the Brighton Corporation Road Restriction
(Sheepcote Road) Order, 1938, made by
the Brighton Town Council under Section
46 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and

drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 15

(Roads Restriction) Order, No. 2, 1937, made
by the County Council of the Administrative
County of Hertford under Section 46 (1) of the

far as the eastern boundary of the River Hiz.
