

Ministry of Health.—Session 1938-39.

BURNHAM AND DISTRICT WATER.

(Extension and modification of limits of supply.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Minister of Health on or before the 23rd day of December next by the Burnham Dorney & Hitcham Waterworks Company Limited whose registered address is at Burnham in the County of Buckingham (hereinafter called "the Undertakers") for a Provisional Order under the Gas and Water Works Facilities Act 1870 and the Gas and Water Works Facilities Act 1870 Amendment Act 1873 for all or some of the following purposes that is to say:—

1. To extend the limits of supply of the Undertakers so as to include the Parish of Dorney in the Rural District of Eton in the County of Buckingham together with those portions of the borough of Slough and of the parish of Burnham in the said Rural District which prior to the coming into operation of the Bucks (Slough Urban District) Confirmation Order 1930 and the Bucks Review Order 1934 respectively formed parts of the Parish of Dorney.

2. To authorise the Undertakers to continue maintain and use any mains pipes or other works laid down or constructed by them prior to the commencement of the intended Order.

3. To modify the limits of supply of the Undertakers by the exclusion therefrom of:—

(a) So much of the Burnham Ward of the Borough of Slough as lies to the south of the Great Western Railway and to the east of a line commencing on the north at the bridge carrying the Great Western Railway over Windsor Lane in the said Ward and extending thence in a southerly direction through the village of Cippenham to the western boundary of the Cippenham Sewage works and thence in a westerly direction to the western boundary of the said Ward and thence following Roundmoor Ditch to the point where such ditch meets the boundary of the said Ward on the south.

(b) So much of the Farnham Ward of the said Borough as lies north of the Great Western Railway but including the said Railway from Windsor Lane Bridge to Leigh Road Bridge.

4. To confer upon the Undertakers with or without modification or amendment all or some of the powers of the Waterworks Clauses Acts 1847 and 1863 and to vary or extinguish all rights and privileges inconsistent with the objects aforesaid and to confer other rights and privileges.

And notice is hereby also given that on or before the 30th day of November instant a copy of this advertisement as published in the London Gazette will be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Council of the Administrative County of Buckingham at his office at the County Hall, Aylesbury and a copy of the said advertisement together with a map showing the boundaries of the existing limits of supply of the Undertakers and the proposed extension and modification of the

existing limits of supply will be deposited on or before the said date at the office of the Ministry of Health, Whitehall, London, S.W.1.

Printed copies of the draft Provisional Order will be deposited at the office of the Ministry of Health on or before the 23rd day of December next and copies thereof when deposited and of the Provisional Order when made may be obtained at the registered office of the Undertakers at Burnham, Bucks, and at the offices of the undermentioned Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents at the price of one shilling for each copy.

Every person desirous of bringing before the Minister of Health any objection respecting the application for the Order may do so by letter addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, on or before the 15th day of January next and a copy of such objection must at the same time be sent to the undermentioned Solicitors or Parliamentary Agents and in forwarding to the Minister such objection the objectors or their Agents shall state that they have complied with this requirement.

CORSHAM WATER.

(Confirmation of construction of waterworks; construction of new waterworks; additional capital, financial provisions, increase of rates and charges, provisions relating to supply of water by the Undertakers, incorporation repeal and amendment of Acts &c.)
