#### BACON INDUSTRY ACT, 1938.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries and the Secretary of State for Scotland, acting in conjunction, and with the approval of the Treasury, have made Regulations in pursuance of Section 27 (2) of the Bacon Industry Act, 1938, entitled:—

The Bacon Industry (Standard Ration) Regulations, 1938, in accordance with which the composition and price of a ration of feeding stuffs to be taken as the standard ration for pigs for the purposes of the said Section 27 shall from time to time be determined.

##### DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACTS, 1894 TO 1937.

Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

*Order No. 5773.*

(Dated 28th November, 1938.)

##### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER OF 1938.

Applies the provisions of the Order to any area declared by a Special Order of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries to be an

Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease. Prescribes the Restrictions to be placed on the movement of animals out of, into, and within an Infected Area, and on markets and sales and gatherings of animals at Certification Centres approved under the provisions of Part II of the Livestock Industry Act, 1937, in an Infected Area. Specifies the form of licences to be used for the movement of animals and the conditions applicable to such licences.

Details the general precautions to be taken in an Infected Area.

Prohibits hunting and the racing or coursing, or training for racing or coursing, of hounds or dogs in an Infected Area. Prohibits the holding of markets of imported animals in an Infected Area and prescribes the restrictions to be placed on the movement of imported animals into or within an Infected Area.

This Order comes into operation on the 1st December, 1938, and revokes the Orders described in the Schedule.

##### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (CONTROLLED AREAS RESTRICTIONS) GENERAL ORDER OF 1938.

Applies the provisions of the Order to any area declared by a Special Order of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries to be a Controlled Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease. Prescribes the Restrictions to be placed on the movement of animals out of, into, and within a Controlled Area, and on markets and sales and gatherings of animals at Certification Centres approved under the provisions of Part II of the Livestock Industry Act, 1937, in a Controlled Area. Specifies the form of licences to be used for the movement of animals and the conditions applicable to such licences.

Prescribes the restrictions to be placed on the movement of imported animals into a Controlled Area and prohibits the holding of markets of imported animals in a Controlled Area.

Details the general precautions to be taken in a Controlled Area.

This Order comes into operation on the 1st December, 1938.
