DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACTS, 1894 TO 1937.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Order:—

Order No. 5782.

(Dated 9th December, 1938.)

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 6 OF 1938.

SUBJECT.

I. Revokes Order No. 5781.

II. Declares the Area described in the First Schedule to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease and applies the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 to such Area.

III. Provides that that part of the Infected Area around Little Marlow, Buckinghamshire, described in the Second Schedule and which is included in the infected area declared by Article 2, shall cease to form part of the Infected Area around Little Marlow.
