3. To confer upon the Company all or any powers commonly conferred on gas undertakers and not hereinbefore referred to and to enact all such provisions as may be deemed expedient for effecting the purposes of the intended Order.

4. To incorporate with the Order the provisions of the Gasworks Clauses Act 1847 and the Gasworks Clauses Act 1871 with modifications and exceptions and to exempt the Company from some of the provisions of those Acts and to amend or repeal or apply or incorporate with the Order with or without modifications all or some of the provisions of the Horsham Gas Orders 1877 to 1929.

Any local or other public authority, company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.I, and despatched on or before the 14th day of January, 1939.
