

At the Court at *Buckingham Palace*, the 20th day of *December*, 1938.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94; of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94; and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme or Representation, bearing date the 24th day of November, 1938, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting under the provisions of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late

Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme or Representation for altering the boundaries of the New Parish of Saint Mary, Hunslet, of the New Parish of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, and of the New Parish of the Holy Spirit, Beeston Hill, all in the County of York and in the Diocese of Ripon:

"Whereas a separate District for spiritual purposes has been constituted and annexed to the Church of Saint Mary, Hunslet, a District Chapelry has been assigned to the Church of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, and a Consolidated Chapelry has been assigned to the Church of the Holy Spirit, Beeston Hill, by the Orders in Council, the dates of which are stated in the third column of the following Table:—

"And whereas the said District of Saint Mary, Hunslet, the said District Chapelry of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, and the said Consolidated Chapelry of the Holy Spirit, Beeston Hill, have become New Parishes of the character contemplated by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, by the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, and by the above-mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parishes should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Geoffrey, Bishop of Ripon (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Hunslet, of the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, and of the said New Parish of the Holy Spirit, Beeston Hill, shall be altered so that (first) all those portions of the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Hunslet, and of the said New Parish of the Holy Spirit, Beeston Hill, which are described in the First Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such New Parishes and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, and

(secondly) all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such New Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Hunslet.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending or proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

" THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, in the County of York and in the Diocese of Ripon, comprising:—

"I. All that portion of the New Parish of Saint Mary, Hunslet, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon the north by the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Hunslet Moor, upon the west by the New Parish of the Holy Spirit, Beeston Hill, in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the south-east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of the Holy Spirit, Beeston Hill, from the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Hunslet, at the junction of Dewsbury Road and Garnet Road, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Garnet Road for a distance of 18 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New
