"Whereas by the authority of an Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the 19th day of July, 1870, and published in the London Gazette on the 22nd day of the same month, a District Chapelry was assigned to the consecrated Church of Saint John the Evangelist situate in the Parish of Hollington, in the said County and Diocese, and the said District Chapelry was named 'The District Chapelry of Saint John the Evangelist, Hollington':

"And whereas by the authority of an Instrument bearing date the 21st day of July, 1881, and being under our Common Seal and under the hand and seal of the Right Reverend Richard, then Bishop of Chichester, which Instrument was published in the London Gazette on the 2nd day of August, 1881, a part of the Parish of Saint Mary-in-the-Castle, in the said County and Diocese, was assigned as a Particular District to the consecrated Church called Christ Church, Blacklands, and the said Particular District was called 'The Particular District of Christ Church, Blacklands ':

District of Christ Church, Blacklands ': "And whereas the said District Chapelry of Saint John the Evangelist, Hollington, and the said Particular District of Christ Church, Blacklands, have under the provisions of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, become New Parishes of the character contemplated by that Act, by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, and by the above mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us, and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Hollington, and of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands, should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

" Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend George, Bishop of Chichester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Hollington, and of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands, shall be altered so that all those portions of the Parish of Ore, in the said County and Diocese and of the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Hollington, which are described in the Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such Parish and New Parish respectively and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament. " THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands, in the County of Sussex and in the Diocese of Chichester, comprising:—

" I. All that portion of the Parish of Ore, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon the south and upon the west by the said New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the north-west, upon the north-east, and upon the east by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which. divides the said New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands, from the said Parish of Ore crosses the middle of Down's Road, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Down's Road for a distance of six chains or. thereabouts to a point opposite to the southwestern end of the wall or fence forming the northern boundary of the close numbered 559 upon the Ordnance Survey Map of the County and Parliamentary Borough of Hastings published in the year 1929 on the scale of 25 inches. to a mile and also upon the map or plan annexed to this Scheme or Representation, and extending thence first eastward to such wall or fence and then north-eastward along such wall or fence and the wall or fence forming the northern boundary of the close numbered 562 upon the said maps for a distance in all. of 14 chains or thereabouts to the point where: the last mentioned wall or fence reaches the western side of Elphinstone Road, and extending thence first eastward to and then southwestward along the middle of Elphinstone Road for a distance of 17<sup>1</sup>/<sub>1</sub> chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the western end of the wall or fence forming the southern boundary of the close numbered 566 upon the above mentioned maps, and extending thence eastward to and along such wall or fence and along the walls or fences forming the southern boundary of the closes numbered 628 and 742 upon the said maps for a distance of 221 chains or thereabouts to the point where the last mentioned wall or fence reaches the western side of Parker Road, and extending thence first south-eastward to and then south-westward along the middle of Parker Road for a distance of 10 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said Parish of Ore from the said New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands.

" II. And also all those contiguous portions of the New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Hollington, in the said County and Diocese, and of the said Parish of Ore which, taken together, are bounded upon the east and upon the south-east by the said New Parish of Christ Church, Blacklands, upon the south-west by the Parish of Saint Matthew (Silverhill) in the said County and Diocese and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the north, by an imaginary line commencing at the point south of Buckshole Reservoir where the boundary which divides the said Parish of Saint Matthew (Silverhill) from the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Hollington, diverges northward from following the middle of Old Roar Stream, and extending thence northeastward in a straight line for a distance of 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of Saint Helen's Road opposite to the western end of the wall or fence forming the boundary
