### RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

#### IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

#### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 14 OF 1938.

##### SUBJECT.

I. Declares the Area described in the First Schedule to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease and applies the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 to such Area.

II. Provides that the Area described in the Second Schedule shall cease to be part of the Infected Area around Lisvane, Glam.

##### FIRST SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising:—

#### IN THE COUNTY OF BRECKNOCK.

The petty sessional divisions of Crickhowell and Brynmawr.

*In the petty sessional division of Talgarth.*

The parish of Llanellieu; and so much of the parish of Talgarth as lies to the east of the road running from Aberllynfi via Porthamal, Talgarth, Tre Walkin, Pen-y-Genffordd and Ddol-fawr to Cwm-du.

#### IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER.

*In the petty sessional division of Coleford.*

The parishes of English Bicknor, Staunton, Coleford, Newland and St. Briavels.

*In the petty sessional division of Lydney.*

The parish of Hewelsfield and so much of the parish of Tidenham as lies to the west of the road running from Hewelsfield via Chase House, Dannel Hill, Broadrock and Tutshill to Chepstow.

#### IN THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD.

*In the petty sessional division of Ross.*

The parishes of Welsh Bicknor and Goodrich.

*In the petty sessional division of Harewood End.*

The parishes of Canarew, Whitchurch, Marstow, Welsh Newton, Llangarren, Llanrothal, Garway, St. Weonards, Tretire with Michaelchurch, Pencoyd, Llanwarne, Llandinabo and Orcop; so much of the parish of Much Dewchurch as lies to the south-west of the road running from Thruxton via Tram Inn Station, Kivernoll, Much Dewchurch Church and Wormelow Tump to Llandinabo; and so
