FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 1 OF 1939.

SUBJECT.

Declares the Area described in the Schedule to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease and applies the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 to such area.

SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising:—

IN THE COUNTY OF NORFOLK.

The city and county borough of Norwich (*except that part of the bed of the River Yare as lies to the east of the parish of Thorpe next Norwich*).

The petty sessional divisions of Eynsford, Forehoe, Wayland and Mitford and Launditch.
