NORTH WALES AND CHESTER CIRCUIT.

The Lord Chief Justice has directed that the Assizes appointed for Dolgelly on the 25th January shall not be held.

By virtue of an Act passed in the 24th year of the Reign of His Majesty King George III, intituled, "An Act to repeal so much of two Acts made in the 10th and 15th years of the Reign of His present Majesty, as authorizes The Speaker of the House of Commons to issue his Warrant to the Clerk of the Crown for making out Writs for the Election of Members to serve in Parliament in the manner therein mentioned, and for substituting other provisions for the like purposes;" And of an Act passed in the 26th year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria intituled "An Act to further limit and define the time for proceeding to Election during the Recess."

I do hereby give Notice, That the Death of Sir Samuel Servington Savery, Knight, late a Member serving in this present Parliament for the County of York, East Riding, Holderness Division, hath been certified to me in writing under the Hands of Two Members serving in this present Parliament and that I shall issue my Warrant to the Clerk of the Crown to make out a New Writ for the Electing of a Member to serve in this present Parliament for the said Division at the end of Six days after the insertion of this Notice in the London Gazette.
