TREASURY MINUTE DATED 6TH JANUARY, 1939.

My Lords read Section 8 of the Currency and Bank Notes Act, 1928.

The Chancellor of the Exchequer informs the Board that the Governor and Company of the Bank of England have represented to him this day that it is in their opinion expedient to increase the amount of the fiduciary note issue from 260 million pounds to 400 million pounds for such period not exceeding three months as the Treasury may think proper. He proposes accordingly to authorise the Bank to issue fiduciary bank notes to the increased total amount of 400 million pounds for such period not exceeding three months as the Treasury may think proper.

My Lords approve and direct that the Bank of England be notified accordingly.

Let a copy of this Minute be laid before both Houses of Parliament under Section 8, Subsection 3, of the Currency and Bank Notes Act, 1928.
