thereof shall be paid subject to such conditions as we the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners shall deem expedient towards the stipend of a Curate or Curates to serve the area or areas or a part or parts of the area or areas intended to be comprised within such new District or Districts.

" 9. That upon the union taking effect the balance of the funds in the hands of the Sequestrators of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Bartholomew as aforesaid shall be transferred to us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, and shall be held and invested by us for the same purposes as the remainder of the severed or diverted endowments referred to in Clause 8 of this Scheme are therein recommended and proposed to be appropriated.

" 10. That with the consents of the Very Reverend John Harold Richards, now Incumbent of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Philip, of the Reverend Oswald Ernest Meatyard, now Incumbent of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Gabriel, and of the Reverend Canon Travers Guy Rogers, now Incumbent of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Martin (which consents are testified by their respectively signing this Scheme), upon the union taking effect: (a) all that part of the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Bartholomew, which lies to the west of the middle of Moor Street shall be transferred and annexed for all ecclesiastical purposes to the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Philip; (b) all that part of the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Bartholomew, which lies to the south of the middle of the Stour Valley Branch line of the London Midland and Scottish Railway shall be transferred and annexed for all ecclesiastical purposes to the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Gabriel: (c) all that part of the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Philip, which lies to the east of the middle of Moor Street (at or near its junction with Dale End) shall be transferred and annexed for all ecclesiastical purposes to the Parish of the United Benefice: (d) all that part of the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Martin, which lies to the west of the middle of Worcester Street shall be transferred and annexed for all ecclesiastical purposes to the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham,

Saint Philip, and (e) all that part of the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Philip, which lies to the east and south of an imaginary line extending from the southern boundary of that Parish along the middle of Worcester Street to its junction with New Street, thence along the middle of New Street to its junction with High Street, thence along the middle of High Street to its junction with Carrs Lane and thence along the middle of Carrs Lane to the eastern boundary of the same Parish shall be transferred and annexed for all ecclesiastical purposes to the Parish of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Martin.

" 11. That with the consent (testified as aforesaid) of the said Ernest William, Bishop of Birmingham, as Patron as aforesaid of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Saint Bartholomew, after the said union has taken effect the patronage of the United Benefice shall belong wholly to the Patrons of the said Benefice of Birmingham, Bishop Ryder.

" Provided always that the provisions herein contained relating to the sale and disposal of the Church of Saint Bartholomew, Birmingham, shall not take effect until the consents and approval which by the said Measures are made requisite to the sale under the powers conferred by those Measures of the site of any Church shall be obtained to the sale and disposal hereby proposed of the said Church of Saint Bartholomew, Birmingham, and of the site thereof together with any ground annexed or belonging thereto.

" And provided further that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from making any other recommendations and proposals relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Measures, or of any other Measure of the National Assembly of the Church of England, or of any Act of Parliament."
