FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 26 OF 1939.

SUBJECT.

Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Area around Steeple Claydon, Bucks., as from the 10th February, 1939, so as to comprise only the area described in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

Contracted Infected Area.

Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Hardwick, Buckinghamshire.

An Area comprising:—

IN THE COUNTY OF BEDFORD.

In the petty sessional division of Woburn.

The parish of Aspley Heath and so much of the parishes of Woburn and Potsgrove as lies to the south-west of the road running from Woburn Sands via Woburn and Speedwell Farm to Hockliffe.

In the petty sessional division of Leighton Buzzard.

The parishes of Heath and Reach and Leighton Buzzard.

IN THE COUNTY OF BUCKINGHAM.

The boroughs of Buckingham and Aylesbury.

The petty sessional divisions of Fenny Stratford, Winslow and Brill.

In the petty sessional division of Buckingham.

The parishes of Marsh Gibbon, Edgcott, Charndon, Poundon, Twyford, Steeple Claydon, Middle Claydon, Addington, Adstock, Padbury, Hillesden, Preston Bissett, Chetwode, Barton Hartshorn, Tingewick, Radclive, Water Stratford, Stowe, Akeley, Maids Moreton, Foxcote, Leckhampstead, Thornton and Thornborough.
