Whereas in pursuance of Clause 31 of the Forest of Dean District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930, amendments of the said Scheme as set out in the Schedule hereto have been submitted to the Board of Trade by the Executive Board elected under the provisions of the said Scheme:

SCHEDULE.

The Forest of Dean District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930, shall be amended in the following manner:—

I. After sub-clause (3) of Clause 48 there shall be inserted the following words:

"Provided that where the annual basic tonnage of any coal mine has been reduced under this sub-clause, and the owner of that coal mine, having given two months' notice of his claim to the Board, satisfies them at any time that the causes restricting the supply of coal to the Board from that coal mine have been wholly or partially overcome, the Board shall forthwith revise the annual basic tonnage of that coal mine having regard to the tonnage of coal which can be supplied to them therefrom and to all other relevant circumstances, so, however, that any additions to the annual basic tonnage made under this proviso shall not exceed in the aggregate the reductions made under this sub-clause."

2. Clause 52 shall have effect as if for the first proviso to sub-clause (5) thereof there were substituted the following proviso, that is to say:—

"Provided that no compensation shall be payable in any case in respect of any deficiency or any part thereof which is due—

(a) to the inability of the owner to supply coal, or

 (\hat{b}) to failure to supply coal in accordance with the directions of the Selling Committee, or

(c) to a request by the owner that the Selling Committee should not direct supply."
