

Benefice to the Registrar-General to be closed officially.

" 5. That upon the said union taking effect the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Wolverhampton (Saint Peter) shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice and so soon as conveniently may be the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Wolverhampton, Saint Mary, and the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds heretofore usually occupied and enjoyed therewith shall be sold and disposed of by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners at such time or times and in such manner in all respects as to us shall seem expedient and that the net proceeds of such sale shall be held and applied by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, for and towards the cost of the provision of a Parsonage House for the proposed new District hereinafter referred to.

" 6.—(a) That so soon as conveniently may be after the union has taken effect the Church of Saint Mary, Wolverhampton, shall be taken down and the materials and site thereof, together with any ground annexed thereto and necessary for the use and enjoyment thereof shall be sold and disposed of by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners at such time or times and in such manner in all respects as to us shall seem expedient subject to the conditions and restrictions imposed by the said Measures.

" (b) That the net proceeds to arise from such sale or sales after the payment of expenses attendant upon the sale or sales, the taking down of the Church, the removal of monuments (if any) and all other expenses incidental to these matters, shall be applied by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners as follows, that is to say, (1) in payment of the compensation or compensations hereinafter mentioned or in repayment of any advance made for the purpose of such compensation or compensations, (2) for and towards the cost of the provision of a site for and the erection of a Church for a proposed new District in the Diocese of Lichfield to be selected by the Bishop of Lichfield as the District for which such Church shall be built such District to be in the patronage of the Bishop for the time being of the said Diocese of Lichfield and any ultimate residue after the provision of a site for and the erection of such Church shall be added to the Expenses Fund of the Diocese of Lichfield established pursuant to the 32nd Section of the Union of Benefices Measure, 1923.

" (c) That the font, communion table, and plate used for the purpose of the Holy Communion in the said Church of Saint Mary, Wolverhampton, shall in accordance with the provisions of the said Measures and as the Bishop of the Diocese may direct be transferred to the Church of Saint Peter, Wolverhampton, being the Parish Church of the United Benefice or to some other Church or Churches within the said Diocese of Lichfield and the bells, organ and other furniture and fittings of the said Church of Saint Mary, Wolverhampton, or such of them as the Bishop of Lichfield shall select, shall be removed to the Church of the proposed new District hereinbefore mentioned and any of such articles not so removed shall be appropriated by the

Bishop of Lichfield for use in any other Church or Chapel or Churches or Chapels within the Diocese of Lichfield which the Bishop may select or shall be sold and in such case the proceeds shall be added to the fund arising from the sale of the site and materials of the said Church of Saint Mary, Wolverhampton, as aforesaid.

" 7. That upon the union taking effect provision shall be made by the Incumbent of the United Benefice for obtaining the services of a Curate or occasional clerical or lay assistance and a portion of the endowments of the United Benefice namely an annual sum of £100 being part of a larger annual payment at present made by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said Benefice of Wolverhampton, Saint Mary, shall be constituted a fund to meet the expenses of providing for the services of a Curate or for occasional clerical or lay assistance as aforesaid which said fund of £100 per annum shall be paid by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, to the Diocesan Board of Finance of the Diocese as trustees to apply the same for the purpose of paying the stipend of a Curate or the expense of occasional clerical or lay assistance as aforesaid.

" 8. That with the consent of the said Edward Sydney, Bishop of Lichfield, as Patron of the said Benefice of Wolverhampton, Saint Mary (which consent is testified as aforesaid), upon the union taking effect a part of the total endowments of the Benefices hereinbefore recommended and proposed to be constituted an United Benefice that is to say the whole of the endowments other than the annual sum of £100 referred to in Clause 7 of this Scheme at present belonging to the said Benefice of Wolverhampton, Saint Mary (such endowments consisting wholly of payments made and Stock held by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners), shall be severed and diverted from the said Benefice of Wolverhampton, Saint Mary, and from the United Benefice and shall be appropriated and held by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, for and towards the endowment of the proposed new District hereinbefore referred to. Provided always that pending the formation of such new District and if the Bishop of Lichfield shall so direct the income in respect of the endowments including any accumulations thereof so held by us in favour of such proposed new District shall be paid subject to such conditions as we the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners shall deem expedient towards the stipend of a Curate to serve the area or a part of the area intended to be comprised within such new District.

" 9. That after the union has taken effect the Repair Funds now held by the Diocesan Trust of the said Diocese of Lichfield for the Church of Saint Mary, Wolverhampton, shall be transferred to the said Expenses Fund of the Diocese of Lichfield to the intent that the same Funds shall together become and be constituted a Repair Fund for the new Church which by Clause 6 of this Scheme is proposed to be provided out of the net proceeds of the sale of the said Church of Saint Mary, Wolverhampton.

" Provided always that the provisions herein contained relating to the sale and disposal of the Church of Saint Mary, Wolverhampton,
