

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Luke, South Park, Reigate, in the County of Surrey and in the Diocese of Southwark, comprising:—

"I. All that portion of the New Parish of Emmanuel, Sidlow Bridge, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon the west by the Parish of Leigh, in the said County and Diocese, upon the north partly by the Parish of Reigate in the said County and Diocese, partly by the said New Parish of Saint Luke, South Park, Reigate, and partly by the New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Redhill, in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the east and upon the south, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Redhill, from the said New Parish of Emmanuel, Sidlow Bridge, at the junction of Price's Lane and Dovers Green Road, and extending thence first southward and then south-westward along the middle of Dovers Green Road for a distance of 49 chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the middle of the roadway forming the main drive to the house and premises known as Hartswood Manor, and extending thence westward along the middle of such roadway for a distance of 28½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with the roadway forming the north drive to Hartswood Manor, and extending thence first north-westward, then westward and then northward along the middle of the last mentioned roadway for a distance of 9 chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the middle of the stream which flows past the northern side of Hartswood Manor into the River Mole, and extending thence south-westward to and along the middle of the said stream for a distance of 40 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the River Mole, and extending thence first westward and then in various directions along the middle of the River Mole for a distance of 35 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Emmanuel, Sidlow Bridge, from the said Parish of Leigh.

"II. And also all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Redhill, which is bounded upon the north and upon the west by the said New Parish of Saint Luke, South Park, Reigate, upon the south by the above described portion of the said New Parish of Emmanuel, Sidlow Bridge, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the east by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Emmanuel, Sidlow Bridge, from the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Redhill, at the junction of Price's Lane with Cockshot Hill, and extending thence northward along the middle of Cockshot Hill for a distance of 22 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Redhill, from the said New Parish of Saint Luke, South Park, Reigate."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme or Representation have been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such Scheme or Representation

and such Patrons and Incumbents have with the exception hereinafter mentioned signified their assent thereto:

And whereas three of the Patrons of the said Rectory of the New Parish of Emmanuel, Sidlow Bridge, have offered certain objections to the said Scheme or Representation:

And whereas notwithstanding the said objections the said Scheme or Representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme or Representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Southwark.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 113, of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a Scheme, bearing date the 2nd day of March, 1939, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 113, of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for constituting a separate District for spiritual purposes to be taken partly out of the New Parish (some-time Consolidated Chapelry) of Saint Barnabas, Linthorpe, partly out of the New Parish (some-time Consolidated Chapelry) of Saint Cuthbert, Middlesbrough, and partly out of the Parish of West Acklam, all in the County of York and in the Diocese of York:

"Whereas we are satisfied that the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Linthorpe, the said New Parish of Saint Cuthbert, Middlesbrough, and the said Parish of West Acklam are Cures wherein or in parts whereof the provision for public worship and for pastoral superintendence is insufficient for the spiritual wants of the inhabitants thereof and it has been made to appear to us that it would promote the interests of religion that the particular portions of the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Linthorpe, of the said New Parish of Saint Cuthbert, Middlesbrough, and of the said Parish of West Acklam, which are hereinafter
