

the map referred to therein; (2) a Map defining the area to which the resolution applies has been deposited at the City Engineer's Office, Civic Hall, Portland Crescent, Leeds, and will be open for inspection by all persons interested, without charge, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. on Saturdays, and 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on all other weekdays; (3) any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property which may be affected by the Varying Scheme, and any Association representing owners of property within the City of Leeds, and any local Association representing business or industry, may by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Leeds City Council to register without charge

his or their name for the service of subsequent notices relating to the Scheme.

The Leeds City Council intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme and any suggestion as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme should be sent in writing to me the undersigned Town Clerk and Clerk to the Council.
