NOTICE is hereby given that the Coal Commission, in pursuance of their powers under paragraph (b) of Sub-section (4) of Section 3 of the Coal Act, 1938, have given direction for the exclusion from the operation of the said paragraph of the minerals and substances hereinafter specified which are comprised in a Lease dated 11th December, 1891, and made between Charles Clifton Dicconson of the one part and Blainscough Colliery Co. Ltd., of the other part and supplemental lease dated 23rd February, 1920, and made between Charles Robert Tolver Michael Gerard of the one part and Blainscough Colliery Co. Ltd., of the other part as varied by a deed of Extension dated 11th June, 1937, and made between the same parties (part of which said minerals and substances were sub-demised to the Darlington Brick Co.
