COUNTY BOROUGH OF WEST HARTLEPOOL.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

THE Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of West Hartlepool hereby give notice that in pursuance of Part V of the Road Traffic Act 1930 they have made application to the Traffic Commissioners for the Northern Area for the Commissioners' consent to the running by the said Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of Public Service Vehicles on

roads outside the said County Borough, such application being as follows:—

“ The Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of West Hartlepool being a local authority who are operating an Omnibus Undertaking under the provisions of the West Hartlepool Corporation Act 1919, hereby make application for the consent of the Traffic Commissioners for the Northern Area under Part V of the Road Traffic Act 1930 to their running Public Service Vehicles on the following roads outside the said County Borough:—

(1) In the Borough of Hartlepool from the County Borough Boundary East of Howbeck House along a proposed Town Planning Road to be known as Winterbottom Avenue, Hart Road and Central Road to a point in Central Road at the junction of a lane leading to the Central Marine Engine Works; and

(2) In the Borough of Hartlepool from the County Borough Boundary in Cleveland Road along Cleveland Road, Hart Road and Central Road to a point in Central Road at the junction of a lane leading to the Central Marine Engine Works.”

Notice is also given that any local authority, the Council of any County, or any persons who are already providing transport facilities on or in the neighbourhood of any part of any road to which the application relates may lodge objections in writing with the Commissioners at their offices Nos. 41-45 Grey Street, Newcastle-on-Tyne, not later than the 26th September, 1939.
