LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

Merionethshire Rivers Catchment Area.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives notice that the Merionethshire Rivers Catchment Board have made application under sub-section (3) of Section 5 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, that the statutory map of the Catchment Area be varied so far as relates to the extent of the main river by the addition thereto of certain watercourses.

A map on the 6 inch scale on which the proposed additions are shown by lines in green colour may be inspected, together with a copy

of the statutory map of the Catchment Area, at the Office of the Clerk of the Catchment Board, Tremeivion, Talŷarnau, Merioneth, or at the Offices of the Ministry.

Any objection to the proposed variation of the statutory map shall be made in writing and sent by post, addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, at the address mentioned below, within thirty-one days from the date of this notice.

ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL IN ENGLAND.

Dated 2nd September, 1939.

No. 7/1939.

Whereas the superintendent registrar's district of Barnet is situate partly within and partly without the Administrative County of Hertford;

And whereas that part of the aforesaid superintendent registrar's district and the sub-district and part of a sub-district comprised therein which are situate without the Administrative County of Hertford will, on the 1st day of October, 1939, in consequence of and by virtue of the Hertfordshire Registration Scheme, 1939, made by the Council of the Administrative County of Hertford and approved by the Minister of Health under Section 24 of the Local Government Act, 1929, become a separate superintendent registrar's district and sub-districts respectively;

And whereas it is expedient that provision should be made for the division of the said separate superintendent registrar's district into two superintendent registrars' districts and the union of the superintendent registrars' districts so formed with certain other contiguous superintendent registrars' districts, for the union of certain sub-districts comprised in one of the superintendent registrar's districts so extended, and for the formation of a new sub-district;

Now, therefore, the Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in England in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 10 and 11 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1837, Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, Section 21 (2) of the Local Government Act, 1929, and of all other powers in that behalf, with the approval and sanction of the Minister of Health, hereby orders as follows:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Hertfordshire and Middlesex Registration of

Births, etc., Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1939.

(2) In this Order the term "district" means a superintendent registrar's district, and the terms "existing district" and "existing sub-district" mean a district or sub-district which existed immediately before the 1st day of October, 1939.

2. The parishes specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto (being situate in the administrative county specified in the second column thereof) shall be united with the districts specified in the third column thereof and shall be added to and form part of or be constituted the sub-districts specified in the fourth column thereof.

3. The districts and the sub-districts extended or constituted under Article 2 of this Order shall be designated by the names respectively appearing in the third and fourth columns of the Schedule hereto.

4. The superintendent registrar of any existing district with which another district is united by virtue of Article 2 of this Order shall be the superintendent registrar of the united district.

5. The registrar of any existing sub-district which is extended by this Order shall be the registrar of that sub-district as so extended.

6. The registrar of the existing Finchley sub-district shall be the registrar of the Finchley sub-district constituted by this Order.
